- You will investigate real life problems and how legislation and procedures should be applied



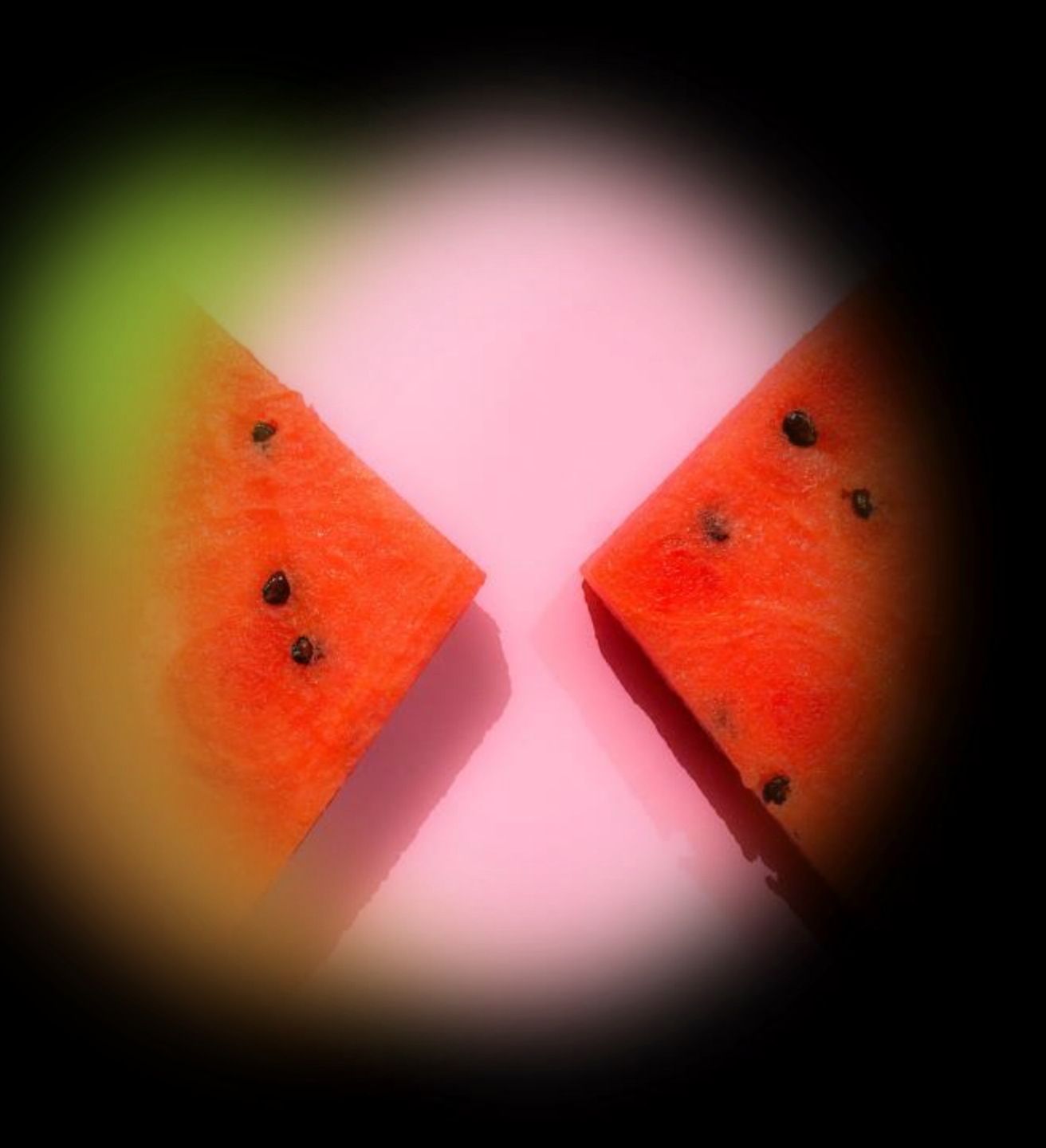
Unit 8 Promoting Public Health
