Crossing points outside Railway station

When crossing the road by Horsham Train Station please remember to use the pelican crossing and be considerate and courteous to road users

We would recommend that you use the Pelican crossings which are signal controlled to gain access to the Railway station. The safest route to the railway station is to cross at a Pelican crossing on Hurst Road, so you are on the correct side of the road, walk up to the roundabout adjacent to the Railway station, bare to the right and cross at the Pelican crossing. You are now safely at the Railway station.

<u>We would not recommend</u> that you use the uncontrolled crossing point which has a pedestrian island in the middle of the road, which is adjacent to the Beefeater restaurant.

ADVERSE WEATHER

Although it is very rare that we would need to close the college unless there is a severe red weather warning, or in the event of a heavy overnight snow fall, or a forecast of heavy snow during the working day, our first priority is the safety of students and staff. In the event of adverse weather, the Principal will endeavour to post a message on the college website by 06:30 to remind staff and students what they should do.

We have guidance on distance learning for managing remote teaching and learning. Teachers should notify their affected classes and then remotely teach via Teams. Students need to ensure they check their college emails regularly for information from the college. All remote lessons should be provided in full and registered using Corero. Remote learning should be marked as an "R" in registers.

Notwithstanding this, students and staff should make the journey to college if it is safe to do so, particularly if they live within a reasonable walking distance. If snow is forecast to fall during the working day, a decision will be made as to whether staff and students who live some distance from the college, and particularly those who rely on public transport, should leave college early. We can't predict or control the weather, but we can be prepared!
